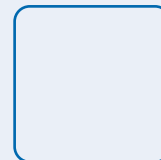

Cabotegravir and Rilpiverine are medications used to treat HIV. Delivered by two injections, they remain effective in the body for two months following the injections.

This is the first available injectable HIV treatment and is not suitable for everyone. In addition to the medical review of its effectiveness for individuals, there is a commitment to attend for blood tests and two injections every **two months**, with a very narrow window for rebooking appointments.
